
**Official Minutes
Of the West Peoria City Council
May 10, 2016**

A regular meeting of the West Peoria City Council was held at West Peoria City Hall located at 2506 W. Rohmann Avenue, West Peoria, Illinois 61604 on May 10, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

1. Call to Order
Mayor Dillon called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance
The pledge of allegiance was led by Mayor Dillon followed by a moment of silence in memory of Mrs. Dohm, a longtime West Peoria resident with a history of service to the community, including Lions Club past president.
3. Roll Call
Members present were Mayor Dillon, Alderpersons Barnes, Dohm, Ganson, Meismer, Reagan, Silver and Thomas. Also present were Township Supervisor De Sutter, City Attorney Martinelli, John Siewert II, Brandon Brown, Rolland Reinhart, David Pittman, Tracy Fox and City Clerk Silver.
4. Additions to/or Deletions from Agenda
No additions or deletions were offered to the agenda.
5. Approval of Minutes – April 26, 2016
Motion to approve the minutes of the April 26, 2016 meeting was made by Alderperson Barnes, seconded by Alderperson Silver.
Discussion: No discussion.

6. Presentation – Friends of Rocky Glen
Friends of Rocky Glen (FORG) Board President David Pittman introduced himself, provided a brief history of how Rocky Glen was purchased from a private owner and gifted to the Peoria Park District and then turned the floor over to FORG board member Tracy Fox. Ms. Fox presented information about Rocky Glen's history and detailed the treasures found within the Glen. Fox and Pittman both shared what steps have been taken and what remains to happen to provide a parking area and public access to the feature.
7. Community Police Report
Deputy Meeks was present until 7:05 p.m. at which time he left to respond to a call. No community police report was given.
8. Mayor's Report
Mayor Dillon reported on a recent experience travelling to Dublin, Ireland (not at taxpayer expense) to represent the City of West Peoria at a Sister City summit. The events included approximately 62 mayors from various twinned cities in attendance and those in attendance were treated to presentations from the Prime Minister and the President of Ireland. Mayor Dillon also reported Clean Up Day on April 30th was a success despite the rainfall, 9 pallet load of electronics were collected. Mayor Dillon also announced he will not be in attendance at the May 26th, 2016 City Council meeting and has asked Jerry Meismer to serve as Mayor ProTem in his absence.

16. Motion to approve Ordinance 2016-07, An Ordinance Amending the West Peoria City Code regarding parking the wrong way on a city street was made by Alderperson Ganson and seconded by Alderperson Barnes.

- a. Finance Committee
Chair Meismer reported Finance Committee met May 3, 2016 and in addition to normal housekeeping, the committee reviewed the TIF residential program, paint program, residential reimbursement program and the invoices voted on tonight. The committee next meets June 7th, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.
 - b. Land Use Committee
Chair Dohm reported the Land Use Committee has not met since the last council meeting's report, the next meeting is scheduled for May 18, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.
 - c. Public Safety Committee
Chair Ganson reported the Public Safety Committee has not met since the last council meeting's report, the next meeting is scheduled for May 17, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall.
 - d. Transportation Committee
Chair Silver reported the Transportation Committee has not met since the last council meeting's report, but updated the assemblage with the status of the sidewalk installation on Sherman Avenue and Moss Avenue, anticipating completion by the end of May. The next meeting is scheduled for May 12th, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Dillon commented on the cost savings that the city was able to realize due to starting the bid process earlier in the season.
18. Public Comment
Township Supervisor De Sutter reported that the Township Board approved a \$2,000 grant to the bike patrol at the Annual Meeting held on April 26, 2016. Mayor Dillon thanked De Sutter for the Township's generosity to this service in the City of West Peoria.
19. Adjourn
Alderperson Meismer made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:43 p.m., Alderperson Reagan seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously by voice.
