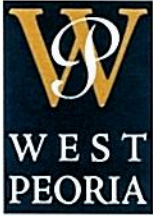

1. Chair Reagan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Roll Call: Members present were Chair Reagan, Alderpersons Martindale and Thomas. Also present were City Administrator Krider, Code Enforcement Officer Davis, John Siewert Sr., John Siewert Jr. and Deputy Clerk Barnes.
3. Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda: No additions or deletions were offered.
4. A motion to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2017 meeting was made by Alderperson Martindale. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Thomas. Motion carried.
5. At this point in the meeting, Chair Reagan excused himself from the room and would return after the Presentation about the Garbage Contract. (6:32 p.m.)

Garbage Contract Presentation – City Administrator Krider asked Dave Schaab from Waste Management if he was comfortable disclosing numbers during an open meeting because that would make them subject to the rules of FOIA – the Freedom of Information Act. He agreed that he was comfortable doing so. He went on to present what rates would be should the City decide to choose to single pay the company after a Referendum getting garbage collection on a pay with property taxes basis. City-wide recycling could be included if the City so decides.

Questions arose from the presentation: Why would recycling need a special container? Special containers are needed to keep the materials from becoming litter.

Why should the residents pay for recycling when the company makes money recycling? Trucks for recycling cost about the same as a fire engine at this time, and additional number of workers would be needed.

Complaint: Totes are good, but two or three days after pick-up they look awful.

By Ordinance totes are supposed to be placed by the curb no sooner than 6 p.m. the day before pick-up, and put away by 6 p.m. the day of pick-up.

Comment: Waste Management has excellent employees.

Chair Reagan returned to the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

A motion was made to send the proposal to Council by Alderperson Martindale.

Alderperson Thomas seconded the motion. Motion carried.

6. No Monthly Financial Report was presented.
7. Public Comment: One resident asked to speak after the Code Enforcement Officer's report.

8. Reports

- a. Code Enforcement Officer's Report was made by Officer Davis.
 - i. Vacant Lots/Structures/Nuisance Properties
Of the seventeen (17) vacant lots in the City, one vacant lot on the report sheet has been sold and is now occupied.
One of the Nuisance Properties has been fined while two others remain vacant.
 - ii. Parking Violations continue, especially parking in the wrong direction on a street. Question was asked about what can be done about repeat offenders? This will be investigated.

Public comment was permitted at this time: Why aren't the codes enforced? Complaints about "junk cars" and how long nothing has been done about them were addressed.

- b. City Administrator Krider reported that she is still working on the City's Disaster Plan and hopes to have a process to all committees by December.
She's also been working on Ordinance 2017 – 30 which is in the packets for this evening.

9. Old Business

- a. Sign Log – Amending Ordinance 1994-18 is waiting for Street Manager Strube's recommendations before acting on it.
- b. Review of West Peoria Fire Protection Emergency Operations Plan is to be continued

10. New Business


