A regular meeting of the West Peoria City Council was held at West Peoria City Hall located at 2506 W. Rohmann Avenue, West Peoria, Illinois 61604 on April 12, 2016 at 6:30 p.m.

1. Call to Order
Mayor Dillon called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance
The pledge of allegiance was led by Scouts Daniel Kerns and Joseph Menke.
3. Roll Call
Members present were Mayor Dillon, Alderpersons Barnes, Dohm, Ganson, Meismer, Reagan, Silver and Thomas. Also present were City Administrator Carlson, Township Supervisor/Troop Leader De Sutter, resident John Siewert II and City Clerk Silver. City Attorney Martinelli arrived at 6:40 p.m. Township Trustee Kennedy arrived at 6:40 p.m.
4. Additions to/or Deletions from Agenda
No additions or deletions were offered to the agenda.
5. Approval of Minutes – March 22, 2016
Alderson Thomas made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2016 meeting with no correction. Alderson Barnes seconded the motion.

The Peoria Election Commission will also be on hand for a presentation. Clean up day will be on April 30 and television and other electronics will be accepted. Mayor Dillon noted that he is attending a Mayor's summit in Dublin, Ireland at his own expense. He will also be travelling to Clonmel to present the city with a plaque for their sister city relations and as a thank you for sending their band. Mayor Dillon also called on the Alderpersons to see him if they are interested in helping out at committee meetings that will be short due to the recent re-location of Ward 4 Alderson Lang. Sunday, April 24th will be a trivia contest between Jimmy's Bar in West Peoria and Carey's Bar in Clonmel via Skype. Alderperson Reagan seconded the motion.
Discussion: Alderperson Meismer noted that this is the last month for the TIF redevelopment program and that the program has been so well utilized that a similar program has been initiated for those residents not in the TIF district that will include a collaboration with South Side Bank.


13. Public Comment
