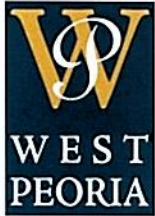

1. Call to Order- Chair Reagan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Roll Call -Members present were Chair Reagan, Alderperson Martindale and Alderperson Thomas. Also present were City Administrator Krider, Code Enforcement Officer Davis, Leroy Dohm, John Siewert and Deputy Clerk Barnes.
3. Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda – City Administrator Krider requested the deletion of the Garbage Contract Presentation that will take place during the November 15, 2017 meeting. No other additions or deletions were presented.
4. Approval of Minutes
 - a. Alderperson Thomas made a motion to accept the minutes from the August 16, 2017 meeting. Alderperson Martindale seconded the motion. Motion carried.
 - b. September 20, 2017 – **CANCELLED DUE TO LACK OF QUORUM**
5. Garbage Contract Presentation – Dave Schaab
6. Alderperson Thomas made a motion to receive and file the of Monthly Financial Reports April 2017 – August 2017. Alderperson Martindale seconded the motion. Motion carried.
7. Public Comment – No public comment was offered.
8. Reports
 - a. Code Enforcement Officer Davis presented the memo from Code Enforcement Officer Wallace about Nuisance Properties and mentioned the detailed list of cases.
 - i. Vacant Lots/Structures/Nuisance Properties
 - ii. Parking Violations – This is an on-going process. Many citations were given early on and it seemed to cut down on the violations – for a while. But more recently, parking in the wrong direction on a street has again become a problem. They will keep working on it.

City Administrator Krider stated that the police are trying to help with the towing of inoperable or standing vehicles. The police are also working with the public as well. A comment was made about needing an Ordinance for Inoperable/Standing Vehicles. This topic will be placed on the next agenda.
 - b. City Administrator’s Report was postponed to New Business.
9. New Business
 - a. Review of Sign Log – Chair Reagan wanted to know how to add other signs than those listed. City Administrator Krider said it could be accomplished by amending Ordinance 1994-18. She also mentioned that it may be needed to verify that the signs are still there or other signs that were added that are not on the list, every 3-5 years.
 - b. Review of West Peoria Fire Protection Emergency Operations Plan – City Administrator Krider presented some questions that are not currently covered in the Plan that we presently have. She will be working on revisions, and asked the Committee Members to familiarize themselves with the Plan. A lengthy discussion followed, asking further questions not already

answered in the Plan. Chair Reagan recommended City Administrator Krider continue working on the revisions. She hopes to have a revised draft by next month. She is also going for NIMS (National Incident Management System) and ICS (Incident Command System) training.

10. Public Comment – No public comment was offered.

11. Adjournment – Alderperson Thomas made a motion to adjourn at 7:29 p.m. Alderperson Martindale seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously by voice.
