*Please note that this information is being taken directly from the IML site and not ALL items are specific to West Peoria.

Duties that are to be performed in the month of **August**.

NOTE: For purposes of this calendar, it is assumed the fiscal year begins May 1st, as it does in most municipalities outside of Chicago. Some municipalities, however, may have adopted a date different from May 1st for the beginning of their fiscal year. [65 ILCS 5/1-1-2\(5\)](#). If so, this calendar must be adjusted to reflect that specific fiscal year.

110. Between August 1 and September 15, nominations for the board of trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund are to be made. [40 ILCS 5/7-175\(a\)](#). NOTE: Cities and villages with a population over 5,000 are automatically subject to the Act. However, participation is not mandatory for any municipality that attains a population of over 5,000 after having provided social security coverage for its employees. Each participating municipality may nominate and vote for the four Executive Trustees who are part of the eight member board. [40 ILCS 5/7-174\(b\)\(1\)](#).

111. In counties other than Cook County, the collector of the municipality shall, at any time after August 15 in each year, publish an advertisement that a return will be made to the general officer of the county having authority to receive State and county taxes of all unpaid special assessments and installments. [65 ILCS 5/9-2-84](#). Publication of the advertisement must be made not more than 30 days or less than 15

days in advance of the date for judgment. Id. Return of delinquent special assessments shall be made five days prior to the date fixed for application for judgment. [65 ILCS 5/9-2-85](#).

112. Any municipality with a population of less than 500,000 which attempts to impose, amend, or repeal the Simplified Municipal Telecommunications Tax must file a certified copy of such ordinance with the Illinois Department of Revenue prior to September 20. Ordinances received prior to September 20 will be collected on or after the following January 1. [35 ILCS 636/5-20](#).

113. On or before the first day of October, home rule and non-home rule municipalities imposing or discontinuing a retailer's occupation tax or effecting a change in the rate thereof must file a certified copy of any ordinance or resolution (and referendum if appropriate) with the Department of Revenue. Ordinances received by October 1 will be collected January 1. [65 ILCS 5/8-11-1](#), and [65 ILCS 8-11-1.1](#).

A regular meeting of the West Peoria Public Safety Committee was held at West Peoria City Hall located at 2506 W. Rohmann Avenue, West Peoria, Illinois 61604 at 6:30 p.m. on July 19, 2017.

1. Call to Order
Chair Reagan called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
2. Roll Call
Members present Chair Reagan, Alderperson Martindale and Alderperson Thomas. Also present were Mayor Dillon, City Administrator Krider, Code Enforcement Officer Davis, Code Enforcement Officer Wallace, Amanda Tritsch, Sherry Tritsch, Alderperson Siewert, Alderperson Dohm and Clerk Silver.
3. Additions to/or Deletions from the Agenda
No additions or deletions to the agenda were offered.
4. Approval of Minutes – June 21, 2017
Alderperson Thomas made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 21, 2017 meeting. Alderperson Martindale seconded the motion. Motion carried.
5. Review of Monthly Financial Report
Alderperson Martindale made a motion to receive and file the monthly financial report dated May 31, 2017. Alderperson Thomas seconded the motion. Motion carried.
6. Public Comment
A resident presented a request for no parking on a specific stretch of Cedar. The Committee debated how to best solve the challenge presented and plan to have Street Department Manager Strube evaluate the stretch of street and determine options.

Code Enforcement Officer Wallace reported on the status of a property in violation on Edna Court, including specific things that have been resolved. Occurrences of parking on unpaved surfaces are down. Garage roof improvements at a property on Laura were reported, and painting progress on a property on Sterling continues. Several nuisance properties owned by the same individual are up for foreclosure auction and details of those, including cleanup of debris, tires and pool maintenance are seeing improvement.
