**4th OF JULY PARADE INFO -** Come be a part of the annual City of West Peoria's 4th of July Parade!

- Parade applications are still available, contact City Hall (674-1993)
- Volunteers are needed!
- Block Captain Ensure entries move along at a steady pace thru the parade
- Sign-In Assist participants with position location in parade. Distribute position number before the parade.

(The last two positions require assistance before the parade so you can still join your family and friends to enjoy the parade.)

- T-shirts are available! For sizes, pricing, and information on how to purchase, contact city hall.
- Children can participate in the Coloring Contest (included in newsletter)
- Grand Marshal Nominations submit a brief letter recommending your nominee to Mayor Dillon at City Hall. The Grand Marshal is a person who has had an impact on the community through social work, public service or volunteer work. Deadline is June 16th.
- Flag Raising Ceremony is held immediately after the parade in Franciscan Park. Winners from the parade will be announced.

### **HOLIDAY FIREWORKS**

The City has adopted a new ordinance regarding Fireworks. On the 4th of July, residents are permitted to use legally recognized fireworks between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. For more information, look at City Code Section 4-7 for all the new rules and regulations. HIGH GRASS AND WEEDS - A friendly reminder from the City.... with warmer weather comes an abundance of new growth. Please be sure grass and weeds are kept mowed or trimmed, especially between the curb and sidewalk, as well as the alley line and behind fences and garages. Any vegetation over 9" high violates the City Code. Please do not blow leaves or grass clippings into the street. This landscape waste can be dangerous and sometimes fatal for pedestrians, bikes or vehicles. Also, it causes storm sewers to back up, which could damage streets and sidewalks.

**WASTE MANAGEMENT -** Our garbage collection service will pick up bulk items (i.e. furniture, carpet, appliances, etc.) FOR AN ADDITIONAL FEE. Please contact them PRIOR to putting bulk items curbside (309-692-6246) or visit their website: www.wm.com.

**GRANTS -** The City Grants are available to all West Peoria residents for projects started on or after May 1st, 2024. Projects started before May 1st WLL NOT be eligible. Please Note: NO CASH PAYMENT TO CONTRACTORS WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Residential Grants: Exterior home improvments, excluding landscaping or fences.

- Redevelopment Grant (RDG) Program Reimbursement of 50%, up to a maximum of \$1,000 of eligible costs. Properties not located in TIF district.
  - IF you are in the TIF district, you will have received a postcard in the mail.
- Redevelopment Grant Program (TIF) District
   1 Grant awards will not exceed 75% of the verified cost of the project, up to \$1,000.
   TIF residents only.

Neighborhood Safety Improvement Grant - Reimbursement of up to 75% of costs, not exceeding \$300 to install outdoor security camera(s) with recording capabilities.

Paint Program - Receive 75% reimbursement of paint costs up to a maximum of \$250 for EXTE-RIOR PAINTING of your home and/or accessory structures.

**DOOR TO DOOR SOLICITATION! -** It is unlawful for any person or organization to solicit any goods or services by going door-to-door within the City of West Peoria.

Please note that the City will post any approved applications on the website to notify the residents. If you have questions, concerns, or complaints about the approved organization or person, please email the City Administrator at: administrator@cityofwestpeoria.com. We take those complaints seriously and will do our best to keep West Peoria a community where you want to live.

# WEST PEORIA FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

We would like to thank the citizens of West Peoria for voting in April to help us keep the ambulance and fire department. As the West Peoria Fire Department strives to continue to meet the ongoing needs of the West Peoria community, I would like to share the overall statistics of 2023 and the calls received as of April, 2024.

For the year 2023, a total of 781 calls were made: 21 fire calls, 546 EMS calls, 26 false fire alarms, 19 hazardous materials alarms, 3 weather related calls, 108 good intent calls (calls cancelled enroute, wrong address, nothing found), and 58 service calls (unauthorized burning, public service, assist police). Mutual aid was given 30 times to other departments and West Peoria received mutual aid on 39 occasions.

As of April 30, 2024, there have been a total of 266 calls: 18 fire calls, 188 EMS calls, 10 false fire alarms, 3 hazardous materials alarms, 39 good intent calls, and 8 service calls. Mutual aid has been given 16 times to other departments and West Peoria has received mutual aid 14 times.

Congratulations to Paige Belzer for being recognized as the Firefighter of the Year and to Kacper Soja as the EMT of the year!

Sandwich Days are back and are scheduled for: June 15th, July 20th, August 17th, September 21st and October 19th!

Also, mark your calendars! Family Day is coming on Sunday, September 15th, Noon - 3:00 p.m. at the Fire House! Lots of fun for the entire family!






